Marked periodontal bone loss is noted in association with #16, with associated furcation involvement and periapical rarefying osteitis. The tooth is completely devoid of osseous support.

Mesial caries noted in #38.

Remarkable bone loss also noted around #s 18, 38 and 41.

There is evidence of generalized, moderate to severe periodontal bone loss noted with calculus in almost all the teeth. The mandibular anterior teeth seem to be with minimal bone support. *The appearance is consistent with generalized marked periodontitis*.

The generalized bone density and trabecular pattern is within the range of normal.

The visualized borders of the maxillary sinuses appear to be intact. There is no evidence of pathosis within the sinuses.

Bilateral condylar and coronoid processes appear normal.
